**April 6, 2014 The Fifth Sunday of Lent
(Lent: A Journey to Joy)**

In 2009, the Diocese of Sioux City initiated this special collection specifically for the retired and infirmed priests within our diocese. **It is important to note that 100% of the funds raised through this collection stays in our Diocese.** The envelopes are in your packets or you may use any white envelope and mark "Retired and Infirm Priests Collection" and drop it in the collection basket anytime over the next few weeks. These men have offered their life for the people of our diocese, please do whatever you can to show your appreciation. On behalf of all of them I want to thank you.
