Food, Family and Fellowship – A New Program

As I mentioned in the homily last week. We are starting a new program in the parish. It is called *Food, Family and Fellowship*. We will be publishing a recipe every week in the bulletin. Each family is to find time to not only cook the recipe, but more importantly eat a sit-down meal together with the TV and cell phones off. Of course, grace must be said before the meal. This is to be a time for families to be together and talk and therefore grow closer. If you are already having such a meal, then add another. If you don't like the recipe, then make another meal. This week's recipe follows.

Recipe of the Week for Food, Family and Fellowship

Chicken Parmesan- Rigatoni Bake

INGREDIENTS

CHICKEN PARMESAN NUGGETS

- 1 lb. chicken breasts, chopped into bite-sized pieces
- 2 Eggs, beaten
- 1/2 c. italian breadcrumbs
- 1/4 c. grated Parmesan cheese
- Vegetable oil

RIGATONI BAKE

- 1/2 Pkg rigatoni pasta
- 1 jar marinara sauce
- 1/2 c shredded mozzarella, plus more sprinkling on the top
- 1/4 cup grated parmesan cheese/
- Fresh flat-leaf parsley, for garnish

DIRECTIONS

- Make the Chicken Parmesan Nuggets: Place chicken and eggs in a gallon-sized resealable plastic bag, tossing to coat. Add Italian breadcrumbs to the bag, sealing and shaking until the chicken pieces are thoroughly coated.
- Pour just enough vegetable oil into a large sauté pan to coat the bottom, and placing it over medium heat. Once warm, carefully add the chicken nuggets, cooking them on all sides until crispy. The chicken should be totally white inside when you cut it open (about 3-4 minutes).
- Place cooked chicken nuggets on a plate lined with paper towels.
- Preheat oven to 350 degrees F.
- Make the Rigatoni: Cook pasta according to package's instructions for al dente. Drain and set aside.
- Assemble the Bake: Pour a little marinara sauce onto the bottom of a casserole pan. In a large mixing bowl, toss the rigatoni with the remaining marinara, mozzarella, parmesan and chicken parmesan nuggets. Ladle the mixture into the casserole dish. Top with a little mozzarella and bake in the oven until the cheese has melted, about 15-20 minutes. Top with fresh parsley if desired.
